



ACADEMIC RULES & REGULATIONS

- Students must attend all classes regularly and on time with discipline and punctuality.
- Wearing the proper uniform is mandatory within the campus and in the Class, practical training yard, PT.
- Students must carry their ID card at all times; entry without it may be restricted.
- A fully shaved, police-style haircut is mandatory. Poor grooming will result in a ₹100 fine per day.
- Mobile phones are prohibited in academic areas; misuse will lead to disciplinary action.
- Visitors or guests are not allowed in classrooms, laboratories, libraries, or training yards.
- Students may bring personal vehicles to campus at their own risk. The institute will not be responsible for any loss or damage
- Students must maintain at least 80% attendance. Below 80% = NC status + ₹5,000 fine; below 65% = DC status + ₹10,000 fine.
- Classes require at least 50% attendance to proceed; if below, the class may be canceled.
- Leave must be requested in advance and approved by the authority. In case of emergencies, proper medical or supporting documents must be submitted after returning.
- Students who are absent for more than three consecutive days must bring their parent or guardian to the institute with a valid reason before being allowed to return to class.
- Absence without submitting a valid leave application will result in a fine of ₹200 per day.
- All fees, including registration, admission, installment and tuition, are non-refundable under any circumstances.
- .All students must appear for internal and final examinations. Internal exams are compulsory and must be passed to be eligible for final exams.
- Students should not loiter on campus or enter office areas without a valid reason. Movement around the campus must be for academic purposes only.
- Participation in college-organized activities, such as industrial visits, adventure camps, mock interviews, and social events etc. is required.
- Students must always show respect to the Principal, faculty, student leaders, and non-teaching staff.
- In the classroom, students must be attentive, avoid disturbing others, and maintain silence and order.
- All theory and practical work should be completed and submitted on time, as per the guidelines provided by the management, to ensure smooth academic progress.
- Smoking, tobacco, chewing gum, alcohol, khaini, gutkha, and other prohibited items are strictly forbidden on campus. Violation will result in fines, disciplinary action, and parental notification.
- Any student causing damage to college property will be required to pay for the repairs or replacement.
- Misconduct, including disrespectful or inappropriate behavior, will not be tolerated and may result in expulsion.
- Students are not allowed to change courses during the session. If a change is absolutely necessary, a ₹10,000 penalty will apply.
- Students who withdraw from the course after admission must still pay the full session fee.
- Students are encouraged to uphold the reputation of the institute, staff, and management both on social media and public platforms. Respectful conduct ensures continued support, including placement assistance, while violations may lead to legal action and loss of such benefits.
- Students are expected to act with honesty and integrity at all times. Upholding these values ensures a safe and trustworthy environment for all. Any violation, such as misuse of funds or documents, will be addressed through appropriate disciplinary and legal measures.
- Online classes may be held via Zoom or other platforms as needed, and students are expected to attend these sessions regularly and punctually.
- Personal relationships between students and faculty or office staff are strictly prohibited.
- If a student is unable to complete a task assigned by the management, a written request from the parent must be submitted in advance. This helps the institute provide appropriate support, though future outcomes will be the responsibility of the student and parent.
- Parents are respectfully requested not to interfere in teaching methods or academic decisions during the course.
- Violation of any rule may lead to termination from the course after a formal show-cause notice.
- The institute reserves the right to change or modify rules as needed for better administration and improvement.
